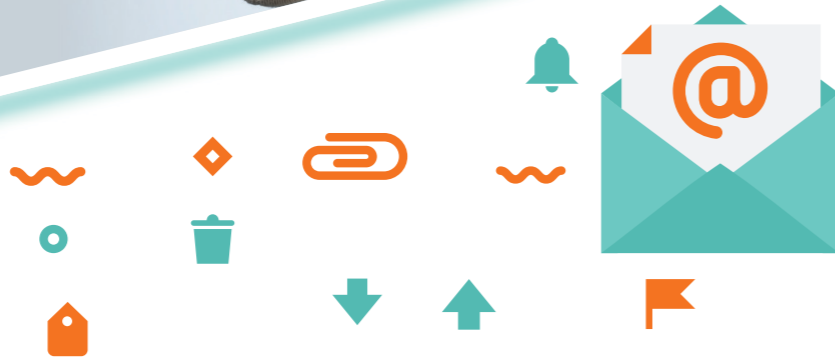

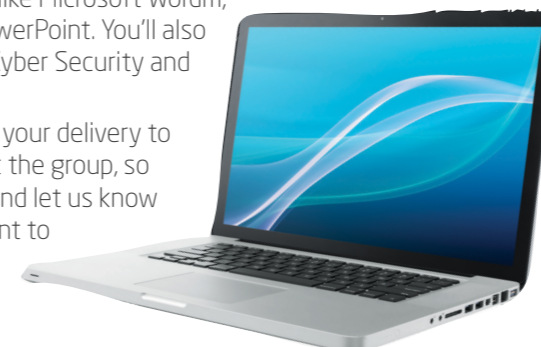


Computing & IT
